hereafter mentioned, and as well for the preservation of the peace in that part of the province as for the ease and benefit of the inhabitants there or which shall hereafter inhabit there do hereby declare & publish that from the mouth of the Choptank River and so downe the eastward side of Chesapeake Bay to Swan point and from thence to the point and so up Chester River to the head thereof it thereby erected into a County and called by the name of Cecil County. And I do hereby further declare that the southerne bounds of Baltimore County by the South side of Patapsco River and from the highest plantation on that side of the River due South two miles into the woods And that the north side of Patapsco River beginning at the north side of Lyons Creek be adjoined to Anne Arundel County And that the Sheriffs of the severall respective Countys of Cecil Baltimore Anne Arundel and Calvert make proclamation hereof in their said Countys respectively and immediately after proclamation shal affix at the Court house door of their respective Countys for witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and caused the lesser Seal of this Province to be present affixed this sixth day of June in the 42nd yeare of the Dominion of Cecilius & Almough Dom 1674.

Know all men by these presents I John Quigley of the City of St. Maries in this Province of Maryland Merchant doe confess & acknowledge my selfe to owe and stand indebted unto the Honble Charles Calvert Esq; in the full and just summe or quantitey of fiftyn thousand pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in easme to conteine the sume to be paid to the said Charles Calvert or to his certaine Attorney his factors or assignes to the which payment well and truly to be made by me selfe my heirs executors and Administrators in the whole sume by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this sixth day of June in the two and fourtith yeare of the Dominion of Cecilius & Almough Dom 1674.

The condition of this present Obligation is such that whereas the said John Quigley hath undertaken to build a Statehouse and prison at the City of St. Maries upon the land within the Liberties of the said City according to the intent & purport of an Act of Assembly made at a Session of Assembly held at the said City of St. Maries upon the nineteenth day of May last past and there continued till the eighth day of August instant intituled An Act for the building a prison and Statehouse at St. Maries If therefore the said John Quigley shall well and truly build and finish the said Statehouse and prison according to the severall dimensions proportion in the said Act mentioned within the line within the said Act limited & appointed
