Whereas I am given to understand that severall plantations in Calvert County in Maryland are legally obligated to me & do hereby petitione and require you to make Sale of w^{ch} any of the said plantations w^{ch} you will and to give patents in my name and under my great Seale of my Province of Maryland of the said lands to such w^{ch} shall purchase them reserving the usuall Rents now paid to me and my heirs for lands held in my Province of Maryland and dispose of what they shall be sold for to such uses w^{ch} I have directed you in my letter dated the 26 Day of this present November 1666 and for so doing that shall be to you a sufficient warrant Given under my hand and Peffer Seale at London the twenty eighth Day of November 1666.

So much as by a late Proclamation bearing date the sixth Day of this instant June some Additions were made to severall Counties upon the Division of that of Baltimore County and by the same proclamation it was there declared that Swan point downe to Hell point on Chespe River should be and remaine for the future belonging to that Eastern side of the Bay lately created and called by the name of Cecil County Upon further consideration hereof it is thought most necessary that so much of the Eastern side w^{ch} was formerly added to Kent County doe still remaine and belong to the said County as afore notwithstanding that part of the said Proclamation in witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and caused the Peffer Seale of this Province to be hereunto affixed the 19th Day of June in the 42th year of the Dominion of Charles the first Anno Dⁿⁱ 1674.
