Same to adjourn & shew him to him and do such places or places in such respective County or the State find to be most convenient for the Disputes of Our Service and ease of the people within the several and respective County as shall be done and justice and right may be equally done in all cases without the cognizance of the said Court of Enquiry and Survey Wee do hereby further wth this and impower the said Baker Brooke to constitute Clerks and other ministers or officers of the said Court such and so many as the said Master fitt unto them to administer Oathes for the due execution of their Offices and by other said Ministers or Officers to cause to be summoned to come before him at such times and places that said Lands in the said Countyes and also jurors good and lawfull men of the same County by whom the truth of the matter may the better be knowne and all persons able to give evidence sufficient respectively upon their oaths to charge to enquire and give evidence that it may legally appear what and how much lands they held of Us what rights and titles they have and hold of Us within this Our Province. By what patent from Us or other meanes conveyance and by what rents and services and the presentments by such jurors to be made and all contempts of this Our Commission to cause to be recorded by the Clerk of the said Court to be constituted and from thence into Our Provinciall Court to be remitted that justice may be done and the people of this Our Province be done all offences and contempts duly punished And Wee do hereby strictly charge and command all Justices of the Peace, Sheriffs Coroners Constables and other Officers and all the good people of this Our Province to be aiding and assisting to the said Baker Brooke in the execution of this Our Commission Given at St. Maries under the great Seal of Our said Province of Maryland this third Day of August in the 43rd year of Our Dominion over this Province Annoq^s Dom One thousand six hundred Seventy four Wth this Our deare Son Charles Calvert Esq^r Our ex^capt Gen^l and cheife Government of Our said Province of Maryland.
