Ordered the Assembly be called together to meet the second Tuesday in  
February next & now with for the Delegates in Baltimore & Cecil  
Countys.

That no Towne or Precinct whatsoever be exported the Province without special  
License from the Governour. vide proclamation Feb 31.

Indian war

The Infurrection of the Indians and the murders committed by them at the head  
of Anne Arundell County was then taken into debate and Ordered that Colonel  
Samuel Shero and Major Wm Burges doe immediately raise the forces under  
their command to follow and pursue the enemies.

And that the same Order be sent to Gods Vics to raise the forces under  
his command, and if there shall be occasion in the other Countys that the like  
Order issue to the commanders there as the Governour shall thinke fit.

That there be two hundred men raised in St Maries and Charles County provided  
with sufficient horse and armes both for horse and foot service, in readiness  
of the march of the Virginia Army and that power be sent up to the Officers  
to presse provisions for them.

There came John Quigley Gent and made a motion to the board on the behalfe of Capt  
Daniel Genifer that whereas Thomas Hodge of Anne Arundell County last May Court  
obtained judgment against Daniel Genifer for seven thousand three hundred pounds  
of tobacco with costs of suite but so as execution thereof was to cease until the  
first day of November next yet notwithstanding the said Thomas Hodge hath  
procured his Lapps writ of ne exeat proin out of Chancery against the said Genifer

Whereupon Ordered that the said writ of ne exeat proin be wholly superseded  
and that the said Thomas Hodge take no advantage thereby.

They was the Provinciall Court to be holden the 26th of October next  
Ordered to be adjourned until the third Tuesday in November next.
