

One shilling on the value thereof to have hold & Enjoy the sole  
priviledge & benefit & advantage of keeping the said Ferry for  
transporting persons & horses over the said River as aforesaid during  
his naturall life provided alwayes that the said Richard Keen  
shall keep a sufficient Boat or Boats man or men for the doing &  
performing the same (wind & weather permitting) And shall not att  
any tym p[ro]p[ri]et[y] to Exart on demand mowd of any person therin  
hereby deuoted him for the same upon paine of forfeiting the Lycence  
Libertye priviledge hereby granted him It being made apperred  
to his Lordys Justices of the Province & County & Ind also provided that  
the said Richard Keen on his o[wn] signes take speciall care to Examne  
Persones that they know not of their owne certaine knowledge to be  
fittmen that so Runaway Servants may not be helpt forwards by  
reason of the Ferry Boat aforesaid And we do hereby Our Command  
Enoyng all Persones what so ever for private game or otherwise to  
forbeare to keepe any Ferry Boat or Boats for transporting other men  
or horses about the said River of Patuxent or any part therof att their  
will given under the great Seale of the said Province of Maryland  
the third day of November in the 44<sup>th</sup> year of the Dominion of Charles  
the 1<sup>st</sup> King of England 1671.
