Then Ordered that there be a party of Christy men raised, fiftene out of S<sup>t</sup> Maryes County & fiftene out of Charles County, to march under the command of Cap<sup>t</sup> John Douglas & Cap<sup>t</sup> Howard Sly, to range the woods about Piscataway & the Susquahanough R<sup>iv</sup>er, to take up all such horses as they shall finde that were lost by the Souldiers in the late Expedition ag<sup>t</sup> the Susquahanough Indians, whose of Jo<sup>n</sup> Burman Joseph Houston, Vincent Mansfield, Richard Brightwell, Mannahawton the Indian & James Smadwood are to be part.

Then Ordered that the Comission<sup>ers</sup> of Calvert County doe adjourn their next County Court till some convenient time after the next Provinciall Court which is to be holden the sixteenth of this instant Novemb<sup>r</sup> that the persons concerned in business at both Courts may give their due attendances at the Provinciall Court.

Forasmuch as divers Charges have arose for the necessary defence & safety of the Inhabitants of this Province in the late Expedition ag<sup>t</sup> the Susquahanough Indians and that such Charges that have so accrued may be defrayed & duly paid, & that just account thereof knowne that an allowance may be made. The Sheriffs of each respective County are Ordered to make publick Proclamacion throughout their respective County that all persons that have been at any Charge & Expences for provision of Amunition or otherwise about the said late Expedition in managing the warre ag<sup>t</sup> the Susquahanough Indians be appear at the next Provinciall Court to be holden at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maryes the 16<sup>th</sup> day of this instant Novemb<sup>r</sup>. & to deliver their severall Accounts thereof to the Sheriff of each respective County that they may have the same ready to deliver in to the Governo<sup>r</sup> & Councell at the said Court given &c
