 Maryland And we doe hereby also graunt unto him the said Baker
 Brooke all such Perquisites Royalties Advantages profits & Allowances
 whatsoever to the said Office belonging or appertaining as fully entirely
 & in as full & ample manner forme & any other of our Surveyors Gen^l
 who had held or Enjoyed the same To have & to hold Enjoy & Exercise the
 aforesaid Office by himselfe or his sufficient Deputy or Deputyes with all things
 thereunto belonging during our pleasure & Commanding also by these presents
 firmly Enjoying all & singular our Sheriffs & other Officers Ministers
 & all other people within our said Province of Maryland that they be
 assisting & Ayding unto him the said Baker Brooke & his Deputy or
 Deputyes in the Execution of the aforesaid Office from tyme to tyme as
 Occasion shall require & comitteth them to doe Given under our hand &
 great Seal of our said Province of Maryland this tenth day of April in
 the first year of our Dominion over our said Province Anno Dni
 One Thousand six hundred Seventy six
