ceeding doe belong And by Judges by them delegated to award
processe sive ploris & determine in all the said Courts & Tribunals
all actions suits & causes whatsoever a well Criminal as civil
personall, reall, mixt & materiall, which being read & heard it
is the judgment of his said Lordship that they are lawfully
authorized and impowered to set up aforesaid according to the
true intent of the said Charter.
