

now build downe or otherwise Destroy Standing Corne or other graine
 whether Indian or Other, nor Tobacco nor any other husbandry or
 Manufacture whatsoever, whereby the Inhabitants of this Province
 seeke to gett a livelyhood for themselves and families, nor commit
 any other wast or spoile w^{ch} breaking downe or burning of fences
 extending to the prejudice and grievance of the said Inhabitants. under
 the penalty of being censured to suffer w^{ch} the Generall Court Marshall
 shall thinke fitt.

17.^o When the Army or any part thereof shall come to engage the Enemy in
 fight, who ever shall runne from his Colours (be he Native or
 Stranger) or doth not defend them to the utmost of his power so
 long w^{ch} they are in danger shall suffer death for it, And whatso=
 ever Soldier shall at any other time run away from his Colours
 shall suffer death or such other punishment as a Generall Court
 Marshall shall thinke fitt. —

18.^o If any Regiment or Comanded party shall not behave themselves
 in fight against an Enemy as they ought to doe they shall
 answer for it before a Generall Court Martiall and the Officer
 or Soldier who shall be found faulty therein shall suffer such
 punishment w^{ch} shall be thought fitt to be inflicted on him by the
 Generall Court Marshall aforesaid. —

19.^o When it shall please God that our Forces shall beate the
 Enemy every man shall follow his Officers in the chase but
 who ever shall presume to pillage or plunder till the Enemy
 be beate, and any misfortune happen he shall suffer death
 or such other punishment as shall be pronounced against him
 by the Generall Court Martiall and the pillage so gotten shall
 be forfeited to the use of the sick and maimed Soldiers. —

20.^o No Officer or Soldier whatsoever to plunder or pillage any house
 or plantation, of or belonging to any the Inhabitants of
 this Province (without leave or necessary reason) much less
 to set fire or lay wast any such house or plantation w^{ch} aforesaid
 more especially any house erected for divine worshipp & service
 whether called by the name of Church Chappell or otherwise
 neither shall they offer violence to any the good people of this
 Province whether men or women, maids or Children more especially
 such as Officiate in either Church Chappell or elsewhere in the
 divine worshipp and service of God whether Ministers or
 others unless such men women or Children and others as before
 said be found actually in armes against them upon paine of death
 or other punishment at the discretion of the Generall Court
 Martiall, but who ever shall force a woman to abuse her and the
 fact be sufficiently proved against him he shall certainly suffer
 death for it. —

21.^o No Soldier shall presume to make any Alarme in the Quarter
 by shooting off his Musket in the night after the watch is set
