Unless it be at an Enemy upon paine of suffering such punishment
as a Court Martiall shall thinke fit.

- 22.^o No Soldier shall bring or draw his sword in any Camp fort or
Garrison upon paine of suffering such punishment as a Court
Martiall shall thinke fit to inflict upon him for the same.
- 23.^o Whosoever makes knowne the watchword without Order or gives
any other word but what is given by the Officer shall suffer
Death or such other punishment as a Generall Court Martiall
shall thinke fit.
- 24.^o A Sentinel who is found sleeping in any fort Garrison Drunck
or the like (whilst he should be more fit duty) shall suffer
Death or such other punishment as the Generall Court Martiall
shall by their Sentence inflict for the same. And if any
Sentinel or private shall forsake his place before he be
relieved or drawnne off, or upon discovery of an Enemy shall
not give warning to his Quarters according to direction he shall
suffer death or such other punishment as the Generall
Court Martiall shall thinke fit. As likewise if any Soldier
employed as a Scout shall not goe upon that Service so farre
as his command, or having discovered an Ambush or approach
of the Enemy shall not returne forthwith to give notice or
warning to his Quarters or if he enter into any house and
there or else where be found sleeping or drunck whilst he
should have been upon the Service he shall suffer Death or
such other punishment as shall be inflicted by the Sentence of
the Generall Court Martiall.
- 25.^o Whosoever shall doe violence to any who shall bring victuals
to the Camp or Garrison or shall take his wages or goods shall
suffer death or such other punishment as he shall be sentenced
to by the Generall Court Martiall.
- 26.^o If any shall presume to beat or abuse his Host or his wife
child or servant of his Host whence he is quartered or killled
he shall be putt in prison for it, and if he doe it a second
time he shall be further punished, and the party wronged
shall have amends made him, and if any presume to quit his
quarter without leue of the Reefe Officer upon the place
they shall be severely punished at the discretion of a Court
Martiall,
- 27.^o No Soldier or Officer shall use any reproachfull or provoking
Speech or Act, do another upon paine of imprisonment
such further punishment as a Court Martiall shall thinke fit
Neither shall any Officer or Soldier presume to send a Challenge
to any Other Officer or Soldier to fight a duell neither shall
any Soldier or Officer presume to upbraid another for
refusing a Challenge for whosoever shall offend in either of
these respects, if he be an Officer he shall loose his pay
and Comand whatever it be, and if a private Soldier he
shall ride the wooden horse and be further punished as a
