

Unless it be at an Enemy upon paine of suffering such punishment as a Court Martiall shall thinke fitt.

22.^o No Soldier shall in any Camp or Garrison upon paine of suffering such punishment as a Court Martiall shall thinke fitt to inflict upon him for the same.

23.^o Whoever makes knowne the watchword without Order or gives any other word but what is given by the Officer shall suffer death or such other punishment as a Generall Court Martiall shall thinke fitt.

24.^o A Centinell who is found sleeping in any post Garrison Fort or on the like (while he should be upon his duty) shall suffer death or such other punishment as the Generall Court Martiall shall by their Sentence inflict for the same. And if any Centinell or sentinell shall forsake his place before he be relieved or dravne off, or upon discovery of an Enemy shall not give warning to his Quarters according to direction he shall suffer death or such other punishment as the Generall Court Martiall shall thinke fitt. As likewise if any Soldier employed as a scout shall not give upon that service so farre as he is commanded, or having discovered an Ambush or approach of the Enemy shall not returne forthwith to give notice or warning to his Quarters or if he enter into any house and there or else where be found sleeping or drunk while he should have been upon the service he shall suffer death or such other punishment as shall be inflicted by the Sentence of the Generall Court Martiall.

25.^o Whoever shall doe violence to any who shall bring Victuals to the Camp or Garrison or shall take his horse or goods shall suffer death or such other punishment as he shall be sentenced to by the Generall Court Martiall.

26.^o If any shall presume to beat or abuse his Host or the wife child or servant of his Host where he is quartered or billeted he shall be putt in stocks for it, and if he doe it a second time he shall be further punished, and the party wronged shall have amends made him, and if any presume to exact free quarter without leave of the Chief Officer upon the place they shall be severely punished at the discretion of a Court Martiall.

27.^o No Soldier or Officer shall use any reproachfull or provoking speech or Act, to another upon paine of imprisonment such further punishment as a Court Martiall shall thinke fitt. Neither shall any Officer or Soldier presume to send a Challenge to any other Officer or Soldier to fight a duell neither shall any Soldier or Officer presume to upbraid another for refusing a Challenge for whoever shall offend in either of these cases, if he be an Officer he shall lose his place and Command what ever it be, and if a private Soldier he shall ride the wooden horse and be further punished as a
