

40. All controversies either between Soldiers and their Captains or other Officers or between Soldier and Soldier relating to their military capacities shall be summarily heard & determined at the next Court Martiall of the Regiment. —
41. In any matter which shall be adjudged in any of the aforesaid Regimentall Court Martialls either of the party that find himselfe aggrieved, may appeal to the Generall Court Martiall who are to take care that if the party appealing make not good his suggestion, recompence be made to the other for the troubles and Charge of such an appeal. —
42. In all Criminal causes which concerne his Lopp and his Government, his Loppes Advocate Generall, or Judge Advocate of his Loppes Army shall informe the Court and prosecute on his Loppes behalfe. —
43. Noe Officers or Soldiers shall presume to hinder the provost martiall, his lieutenant or servants in the execution of that Office upon paine of death or such other punishment as a Court Martiall shall thinke fitt. But on the contrary all Captained Officers and Soldiers shall doe their utmost to apprehend and bring to punishment all offenders, and shall assist the Officers of the Army for that purpose, especially the said provost martiall his lieutenant and servants, and if the provost martiall or his Officers require the assistance of any Officer or Soldier in the apprehending any person declaring to them that it is a capital crime, and the party scape for want of aide and assistance, the party or parties refusing to aide or assist shall suffer such punishment as a Court Martiall shall inflict. —
44. Noe Officer or Soldier of what quality or degree soever shall at any time presume to offer violence to, or lay any violent hands upon the persons of any Embassadors or other ministers sent out to treat with the Generall or other Commander in Chiefe of his Loppes forces, touching peace or war, but that they shall grant and afford, to the said Embassadors or other ministers as aforesaid the privilege of safe conduct with free ingress, egress, regress during the time of such treaty without the least act of hostility to be offered to their persons or the persons of their retinues and attendants under paine of death. —
45. That Officer or Soldier who shall presume to draw his sword in any place of judicature while the Court is sitting shall suffer such punishment as shall be inflicted on him by a Court Martiall. And his Lopp doth hereby authorize the provost martiall of his Loppes Army by his owne authority to apprehend such offenders: and if any Soldier being committed for any offence shall break prison the said provost martiall Generall shall by his owne authority apprehend him & the offender shall suffer death or such other punishment as the Generall Court
