

Ordered likewise that Colonel Jeff. Wharton deliver twenty
arms and ammunition convenient to such twenty men w^t shall
be raised for the assistance of the said King of Mattawo-
mack.

Ordered also that day John Allen do continue to
range above Piscataway and over towards Piscataway with
thirty horse till ordered to the contrary.

The Council likewise took into consideration made by -
Colonel Nicholas Spencer last 12 matchcoats to the
Piscataway Indians, and ordered that those persons who -
shall carry the Amunkey prisoners over to the said
Spencer shall receive from him halfe the said Match-
coates to the King of Mattawomack as a reward of his
service in taking the said prisoners.

Ordered that Mr E. Benj. & Roger and Major W^m Boreman
receive the Lower Indian prisoners from Capt Leis to
Barton and convey them safely over to Colonel Nicholas
Spencer and in his absence to Capt Colonel John Washington
or Major Isaac Alderton, and to bring back the Poptico
Yanconas and Piscataway Indians, and that they do -
provide boats or any thing else needfull for the service -
And Major Boreman is to let the Poptico and Piscataway
Indians know that they are sent over into Virginia only
to tell them the news and so to come back again to -
live with their friends, And to that end Mr E Benj. & Roger
is not to permit the Poptico and Piscataway prisoners
to go on shore in Virginia till Capt Nicholas Spencer
Capt John Washington, and Major Isaac Alderton or
one of them have given him their paroll that they will
permit him to bring the said Indians back into Maryland
again. After which the said Roger is to deliver the
Poptico Indians to the King of Poptico with a strict
command not to receive any more Indians from Virginia
and to deliver the Piscataway Indians to Major Boreman
to be delivered to the Empidrome with like charge.

John Hall of Talbot County having presented his account
against estate of George Beckwith deceased.
It is the opinion of the Council that it is reasonable that the same
be allowed and paid by the Administrator when appointed. and that
the said John Hall take the same care of the estate of the said
Beckwith as formerly did the County Court of Talbot
County otherwise Order and that the said John Hall give
notice hereof unto the Commissioners of the said County at a
Court to be holden for the said County on Tuesday next.
