

Deputy by his Loyp to be appointed as aforesaid from his Loyp and in his
 Name and as often as his Said Deputy shall think fitting from time
 to time to pardon remit or release whether before judgment or after
 all and all manner of Criminal Offences against the Lawes of
 His said Province and Dominions or any of them, and also all
 all manner of French practices & perfidies incurred or to be
 incurred by any person or persons enemies politiques or foreigne
 within this said Province and Dominions or any of them, for or by
 reason of any crime or Crimes Offence or Offences committed or to be
 committed against any the Lawes Ordinances or Orders of His said Province
 heretofore made or hereafter to be made without further occasion
 as fully and amply to all intents constructions and purposed as his Loyp
 himselfe might doo being personally present in the said Province.
 And also for his Said Loyp and in his name and as often as he will say
 Deputy shall finde it necessary from time to time to call assyndle
 and summon any Generall Assembly or Generall Assemblies of the Freeman
 of the said Province or of their Deputies or Delegates for the giving of the
 advice assent and approbation of the Freeman of the said Province to such
 Lawes and acts as shall bee by his Loyp at any time Ordained made and
 enacted and under his Loyp's Seal published and unto which the said
 advice assent and approbation of the Freeman of the said Province shall bee at any
 time necessary and requisite, and the said Generall Assembly and Assemblies
 from time to time called assyndled and summoned or to be called assyndled
 or summoned from time to time sooften as often as his said Deputy
 shall judge it necessary in the name of his Loyp to prouide or
 otherwise to dissolve at his said Deputyes pleasure. And likewise
 for his said Loyp and in his name and in his office from his Loyp
 said Province to Ordaine make and Enact by and with the advice
 assent and approbation of any such Assembly or Assembly as so called
 assyndled or summoned as aforesaid to bee of force untill his said
 Loyp or his heire or assignes Lord and Proprietary or Lords and
 Proprietaries of the said Province shall declare and publish or
 cause to be declared or published within the said Province his
 or some of them their particular diffent or diffe[n]t disagreement or disengreements
 to the same under his heire or some of their Seals or Seales; So
 as the said Lawes and Acts so to be Ordained made and enacted
 be confor[n]m to reason and not repugnant or contrary but as near
 as reasonably may bee agreeable to the Lawes Statutes and Customs
 of the Kingdome of England, and so as this same bee no wayes
 repugnant unto or destructive of his Loyp's Rightes priviledges or
 jurisdictions or to the Distrinction of his Loyp his heire or
 assignes Lords and Proprietaries of the said Province or contrary
 to his Loyp or their power Government or Dominion, or contra
 dictory to a certaine Act of Assembly heretofore made in the
 nineteenyeare of the Dominion of Calias his Loyp's decess
 Father of Noble memory Amongst done One thousand sic
