 the said Lord's conservation as for the conservation of the peace and
 tranquillity of the said Province and to the end that Justice &
 Equity might be duly & impartially administered to all and every
 person and persons Bodies Politique and Incorporate of and
 within the said Province of Maryland Did also constitute assign
 and appoint me the said Jesse Wharton to be Chief Justice of
 the said Lord's Provincia^l Court of the said Province during the
 said Lord's pleasure aswell for the holding of all pleas touching
 or relating unto the conservation of the said Lord and the conservation
 of the peace of the said Province, as for the holding of
 pleas touching the said Lord's rights and Royalties and of Common
 pleas, and likewise for the determining of all matters of
 Equity for which any reliefe is or shall be or may be justly
 or reasonably desired in the said Court. And whereas also
 the said Lord Charles Lord Baltimore did by the said last
 recited Commission constitute assigne and appoint the Deane Lucke
 and Councellor Philip Hubert Esq^r the said Lord's Chancellour
 of the said Province, the Deane Currie and Councellor Wm
 Hubert Esq^r the Principall Secretary of the said Province
 the Deane Currie Baker Brooke Esq^r the Councellor Surveyor
 Generall of the said Province, the trusty and wellbelov'd Henry
 Courjay Esq^r, the trusty and wellbelov'd Councellor Samuel New Esq^r
 the trusty and wellbelov'd Councellor Thomas Cotton Esq^r to be justices
 of the said Lord's said Court for the holding the pleas aforesaid and for
 the determining of matters of Equity aforesaid willing and by those
 presents assigning constituting and appointing that the said Chief Justice
 and the said Justices or any four or more of them (of which if the
 said Jesse Wharton and the said Chancellour and Secretary to be One)
 shall be a sufficient Court for the determining the pleas and
 matters of Equity aforesaid As by the said last recited Commission
 more at large may likewise appear. And whereas likewise
 the said Lord Charles Lord Baltimore did by his Instrument
 in writing or writing of Instructions and Orders under his
 hand and under the great Seale of the said Province bearing
 date the said sixteenth day of June aforesaid intituled
 Instructions Orders and authorities to be observed and executed
 by Our Deputy Lieutenant Colonel Jesse Wharton during Our
 absence out of Our Province of Maryland, and to me the said
 Jesse Wharton directed, the said Lord ^{did} thereby will require
