Charles Absolute Lord & Proprietor of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore of all the Inhabitants and People within our said Province and all others whom these Presents shall any wayes concern Greeting Whereas for the better collecting Receiving & getting in our Rents Ports Duties Impositions & all other profits perquisites & just debts whatsoever in this our Province It is fit and requisite some persons should be appointed & Empowered who from tyme to tyme may Receive Collect Receive & gett in the same Know ye therefore that we reposing much trust & Confidence in our Right Trusty & well beloved Thomas Notley & Benjamin Rozer Gentls have Empowered Constituted & Appointed and we doe hereby Empower constitute & Appoint the said Thomas Notley & Benjamin Rozer jointly & severally our Receiver & Collectors of all our Rents Ports Duties Impositions profits perquisites & debts & due whatsoever in this our Province And to doe & performe all & every things which to the Office & place of Receiver & Collector doth belong or any wayes apperteyne And upon Receipt of any Summe or Summes of money Goods or Tobacco to us due or belonging Acquittances & discharges to make Soales & deliver Hereby Ratifying Confirming & allowing all or whatsoever the said Thomas Notley or Benjamin Rozer or either of them shall doe or cause to be done by Vertue hereof, with full & ample power under them or either of them by Commission under their hands & Seales or under the hand & Seale of one of them to constitute & Appoint such Sub Collectors & Receivers under them as they shall thinke fit with like or limited power And the said Commissions or any of them to Revoke & annule at pleasure Willing & hereby Requiring our said Receivers & Collectors to call to an account once every yeare at the Shewffes of our severall & respective Countyes & at others or Deputy Receivers & Collectors who are hereby Required to give in their accounts accordingly And upon refusal to Account or delay of payment of what shall be due to us from any person whatsoever or howsoever the said persons debts & to us to Impleade & prosecute in our name Hereby also Demanding all & every our Officers & all the good people of our Province to be aiding & assisting to our said Receivers & Collectors as becometh Willing also all our Judges Officers & Ministers of our said Province to allow of this power hereby by us granted to the said Thomas Notley & Benjamin Rozer as a full sufficient & unquestionable authority for them the said Thomas Notley & Benjamin Rozer or either of them to Recover all and singular our just dues within our said Province Given under our hand & our Seale of our said Province of Maryland at our
