 A Proclamation,

— Frome much as W^m Daryes late of the Cliffs in Jahoet County, W^m
 Gent, Giles Hafflam and John Frate with divers others of the same County
 having formerly contrived a certaine Seditious paper tending to the utter
 subversion of the Loops Rule & Government, the destruction of the peace
 of the good people of this Province & the very constitution of Assembly &
 which are the two preservers of the Liberties of the People & the
 — fountain of Our Lawes & justice, did endeavour to publish the same
 under the specious pretences of the preservation of Oure Liberties of
 the freemen of this Province, though in truth they tended to the
 Ruine of the freeholders & housekeepers of this Province & the
 — taking away of just liberty & true property in Our goods & lands &
 tenementes & to that end did On Sunday the third day of this instant
 September at the plantation of Thomas Barbary upon Poynt
 River in Jahoet County aforesaid with force & color of Armes
 assemble themselves with divers others to the number of Sixty persons
 by them seduced in a mutinous & Seditious manner do extort from
 — the Governour & Councill of this Province a grant of the contents
 of that paper being certaine Immunitie & freedoms not within
 the power of the said Governour & Councill nor of the Lord Proprietary
 himselfe do grant without the consent of an Assembly And whereas
 the said Governour & Councill did send to the said W^m Daryes
 and his Complices at the time & place aforesaid Commanding them
 — to pay downe & yeild up their Armes & to retire to their owne
 houses promising to propound their requests to the next Assembly
 who alone could grant their petitions and in the interim promised
 — them all free pardon W^m Daryes only excepted to whom they not
 — notwithstanding promised a free & legall tryall at the Provinciall
 — Court, and that they would not in this case execute Martiall law
 — to his case justly deserved. And whereas these conditions of the
 Governour & Councill were then and there slighted & contumelied
 by the said Daryes Gent, Hafflam & Frate & their Complices
 and that they did from thence march away with drummes breaking
 & Colours flying in despite and defiance of the Loops Government
 and to the terror of all the good people of this Province thought they
 — haue since withdrawn & dispersed themselves & by lurking till
 — they can find a fitter opportunity to work out their wicked & malitious
 — designs. Wherefore by the advice of the Councill in the
 name of the Lord Proprietary to declare publish & proclaim
 — the said W^m Daryes W^m Gent Giles Hafflam & John Frate
 — mutinous and Seditious persons Outlawes & Justice with
 — force and armes & strictly to charge & command all persons inhabitants
 — of this Province not only not to ride about comfort or assist
 — them or any of them upon paine of being proceeded against as
 — mutinous & Seditious persons & punished with death according
 — to the laws of this Province but also strictly to require all
 — persons
