people. And the same with force & terror of arms have
Published at the head of the company commandied by Major Henry
Jowles threatening the said Major with their guns & mortars
presented. These are therefore in the name of the Right Hon^{ble}
the Lord Proprietary to will & command all Officers Military &
Civill & all Houle Peopple to the good People of this Province
to apprehend the said Ensigne W^m Davis Giles Hasselham &
John Pate & them safely to bring to the Garrison at Matapana
Sewall threat to be kept in safe custody, strictly charging & commanding
all housekeepers & all other the good People of this Province not
to harboure comfort aid or assist the said Davis Hasselham & Pate
or any of them as they will offend the contrary at their utmost
peril & And forasmuch as many well meaning People of this
Province may have been seduced by the said Davis Hasselham & Pate
to joyn with them in the publication of the said paper it is hereby
Becalmed Published & Proclaimed that the Governm^t will not take
notice of that crime many other person then the said Davis &
Hasselham & Pate provided they rendred themselves to the Deputy
Lieuten^t or some one of his Lordshippes Council for this Province
within fourteene dayes & shall discover the Council do^s & contrives
& contrives of the said paper given at the City of St. Marys under
the great Seal of this Province of Maryland the first day of Sept^r
in the first yeare of his Lordshippes Dominion annoz Domini 1676

Whereas in these dangerous & Rebellious times there are divers
convict persons Imprisoned into this Province before the tenth day
of November at which day the Act against Importation of convicted
persons into this Province shall take place. And where as it doth
apparele Evidently that the landing of such persons in this conju-
ncture of tyme & affairs is absolutely destructive to the Peace of this
Province Be it Ordained by the Governm^t & Council And it is
hereby Ordained That the Master of the Shipp on Yessent in which
the said Convict persons are Imprisoned shall before he presumeth
to land sete give or dispose of any the said convicted persons within
this Province ou to any person in this Province Entour into Bond
the Lord Proprietary of fifty pounds sterlⁿ with two sufficient Surety
such as any two of the Justices of the County Court of the County in which
the said Convicts shall be landed on whom it is intended to be landed shall
