Shippes & Navies in our said Province of Maryland & in  
our said Islands Territories & Dominions aforesaid And  
also the Custody & Chief Government & Command of our said  
Province of Maryland & of our Islands Territories and  
Dominions aforesaid And of all & singular the Castles  
Fortes Fortresses Fortifications Munitions Shippes &  
Navies within our said Province Islands Territories  
& Dominions aforesaid being & remaining or to be  
& remayne & to us in any wise belonging or appertaining  
ing Together with all & singular the rights priviledges  
Jurisdiction Commodities Advantages & Emoluments  
whatsoever to the said Office & Governour: or either of them  
any wise belonging or appertaining And him the said  
Thomas Motley we doe make ordeyne & constitute Lieut  
General Chief Captaine & Chief Admirall both by  
Sea & land Chief Governour & Commander of our said  
Province
