 presents to have hold, occupy, enjoy & exercise the  
 said Office of Lieutenant Generall Cheife Captain  
 & Cheife Admirall Cheife Governour Cheife Comander  
 aforesaid with the Appulerances unto the said  
 Thomas Notley by himselfe or by his sufficient  
 Deputy or Deputyes by him in his absence to be  
 appointed during our pleasure And we likewise  
 for the Consideracion aforesaid doe give & grant  
 unto the said Thomas Notley full power & authority  
 during the tyme of his Exercise of the said Office  
 before mentioned by himselfe & his Captaines &  
 Officers by him to be appointed to Leaby Master  
 & huayne all sorts of men of what condition or  
 wheresoeuer borne in our said Province & Domi-  
 nions southe by me being or remaining And in  
 case of Insurrections, Assailes or Approaching  
 of any Enemy or Enemys Pyrate or Pyrates or  
 other Robbers to make warre to pursue such enemy  
 or enemys Pyrates or Robbers at warr by sea as  
 land and to Vanquish & take them And being so  
 taken to putt them or any of them to death by the  
 Law of warre, or to save them or any of them at  
 his pleasure And to doe all & every thing & things  
 which unto the Charge & Office of a Captainne Generall  
 of an Armey or Admirall of a Fleet belongeth And  
 likewise in case of any Rebellion, tumult or sedition  
 either upon the land within our said Province &  
 Dominion or upon the seas to Exercise Martiall  
 Lawes against all Rebels multinous or seditious  
 persons of those parts who shall refuse to submit  
 themselves to our Government, or to serve in the  
 wares, or shall fly to the Enemy or forsake the  
 Ensignes, or be Louterers or Straglers or officers  
 wheresoever offending against the Law custome or  
 Discipline Military as freely & nad ample —
