

Our summoned from tyme to tyme when & as often  
 as we shall judge it necessary in our name to  
 prorogue or otherwise to dissolve at his pleasure  
 And likewise for us & in our name & in our  
 absence summond said Province to Ordayne  
 make & Enact by & with the advice assent &  
 approbation of any such Assembly or Assemblie  
 so called assembled or summond or to be called  
 as aforesaid to be offente unte we our selfe  
 or our heires or assigns Lord & Proprietary or  
 Lords & Proprietaries of the said Province shall  
 declare & Publish or cause to be declared or published  
 within our said Province our said their or some of  
 their particular dissent or difficult disagreement  
 or disagreements to the same under our heire  
 or some of their Seale or Sealed so as the said  
 Lawes & Acts so to be Ordained made & Enacted  
 be consonant to reason & be not repugnant or  
 contrary but as near as conveniently may be  
 agreeable to the Lawes Statutes & Customs of  
 the Kingdom of England. & so as the same be  
 no way repugnant to or destruction of our Rights  
 Priviledges or Jurisdictions or to the Disinheri-  
 son of us our heires or assigns Lord & Proprietary  
 or Lords & Proprietaries of the said Province or  
 contrary to our or their Powers Government or  
 Dominion or contradictory to a certaine Act of  
 Assembly heretofore made in the nineteenth  
 yearre of the Dominion of our late deare & most  
 noble father Kinge <sup>James</sup> in One thousand six  
 hundred & fifty Instituted and concerning  
 Religion And likewise wee doe farther give  
 Grant unto the said Thomas Notley during the  
 tyme of his exercise of the said Office aforesaid  
 such power & Authority from tyme to tyme to make  
 constitute Ordayne & Publish in our name such  
 wholesome reasonable & profitables Ordinances
