 & require as also strictly charge & command all singular
 his Lordps Officers civil & military within this Province
 & others the good people of the same to take due Cognizance
 of such peace made & concluded as aforesaid That
 from hence forward they offer no violence or injury
 or use any act of hostility ag^t the said Nations of Indians
 or any of them, but that at all tymes & upon all
 occasions they maintaine & keep a friendly neighbourly
 correspondency with all & every the said Nations of
 Indians & treat them civilly & courteously as friends
 & Neighbours giving them no just occasion of offence
 whereby a breach may ensue Given at St James
 under the great Seal of this Province the fifth day of
 Octob^r in the second yeare of the dominion of his said
 Lordps Charles 2^d over this Province Anno Dom^o 1671

Whereas at the laying of the publick Levy of this
 Province for these two yeares last past, itt hath been
 the custome & practice of severall the Sheriffes within
 this Province to bring in rebatem^{ts} for severall
 persons returned in their lists of Tithables
 alledging that they are run away or dyed insolvent
 which is thought to happen merely through the
 remissnes & negligence of the Sheriffes themselves
 not taking care to search or collect the same in due
 tymes presuming that they shall be allowed for the same
