

Driving away their stocks into places remote from their
 owners usual & accustomed haung to their great losse and
 damages, for prevention of which great diffusabillity for the
 future I doe hereby by & with the advice & consent of the
 Lordes Council strictly prohibitt & forbid all & eall manner
 of persons whatsoeuer to haunge or hunt for wilde Cattie,
 houseth, hogges, in his Lordes forrest or elsewhere within the
 Province, except it be upon his or their own proper land
 without a license first had & obtained from my selfe or other
 person on persons lawfully authorized & impowered to
 graunt the same, he or they obtayning such license -
 giving good & sufficient security that he or they shal
 not any wayes injure or affre any violence to or in any
 wise damage any of his Lordes good people the Inhabitants
 of this Province in their stocks of Cattie or hogges, & that he
 he or they haunting obtained such license, shall not by
 vertue thereof presume to plant in any maner or eise
 whereof upon any mans land without leave or liberty
 so to doe first had & obtained from the person or persons
 living upon the same or to whom the said land of eight
 hundred acres I doe hereby by & with the advice & consent
 aforesaid further strictly charge & command all & singular
 his Lordes Justices of the peace within this Province & other
 publike Ministers of the same to take due Cognizance of
 the same & that all persons whatsoeuer within the severall
 respective Countys & parishes that shall offend therin or act
 contrary to the true intent & meaning hereof they bind to
 their good behaviour rausing hem or them so offending to
 give good security for the same & for his or their appearance
 the next Provinciall Court to be holden for this Province after
 such offence done committed given at the City of St. Marys
 under the greater Seal of this Province the second day of October
 in the second yearre of the reigne of the right Honble
 Charles et deo & this Province dñe 1677
