Brethren we are now come upon yo^r sending for
Whence we have alwayes had a firm Covenant with
this Governm^t which hath been faithfully kept by the
Governor you & whom we have taken to be our
greatest Lord, for which we doe give him hearty thank
you he hath putt aside all mistakes which have hap-
pened, we never had warre with this Government
but with yours, & now you are come from Maryland &
Virginia to speake with us in his pson, and lett that
which you have proposed to us be as fast & firm as the
Covenant we have with the Governor you & we
humbly thank you that you have sent for us to speake
with us in this Governm^t, & doo sent half a boar.

You are come here to speake with us of good things, & we
will give you a good answer therupon, doo gibe one
boar.

We thank you that you doo busy & forget all former
disfronitute & injuries, as we doo the same, & never
more to be remembred, for we know very well our
people have been offensib^e unto you, we desire and
recommend unto you the continuation of the Covenant
now made betwixt us, & that which we have with this
Governor you & doo gibe one boar.

In case any of yo^r Indians doe any hostilitie to us, we
shall acquaint you therewith, before we take up the
a^c against them and we desire the like of you also
the reason that we plundered the English there, was
their entartaining of those Indians that were our
