officers of his regiment to doe the like And I shall
send orders to Col^t Douglas to the same effect; for I
think it very necessary to be in a readiness, & that
we have mens fit occasion require. If you think
any thing more at present (before we gett further
intelligence from Son^r Gent County) to be done or desired or
advised, Let me hear from you at the S^t. Mary^s post
whom I sent downe to the Province this morning. Let
the person entrusted to be sent to Son^r Gent County for
intelligence be instructed to make a speedy returne, if
there be any great danger. I shall not trouble you more
at present, but leave you to consider & advise upon the
emissary, & expect your Answer hereunto at the S^t. Mary^s
