 Towne, one att John Griggs's. In Ann Arundell
 County, one att the Courthouse, one att Richard Hille,
 & one att the red Lyon At the Court house in Talbot
 County one att the Court house in Kent County one,
 At the Court house in Cecil County one att the Court
 house in Baltimore County one, At the Court house in
 Dorchester County one, And att the Court house in Saint
 County one We doe therefore hereby impower &
 authorize our dear Cousin Will Calvert Esq: our
 Siry of our said Province to grant licence or licences
 to such person or persons as shall undertake to keep
 Ordinary as aforesaid att the said severall & respective
 places & within the Countys above said The said
 Ordinary keepers in the City of St. Marye paying
 yearly to our said Cousin the summe of two thousand
 pounds of tobacco each person And all other the
 Ordinary keepers or such as shall keep Ordinary at
 the places above said the summe of twelve hundred pds
 of tobacco yearly each person And that the respective
 Ordinary keepers doe & shall pay for their severall &
 respective licences yearly to our said Cousin the summe
 of twenty shillings sterl, & to his Clerk five shillings
 sterl for their & every of their licences to keep
 Ordinary And further we doe hereby authorize &
 impower our said Cousin to ass demand receive & take
 not only the aforesaid quantityes of tobacco so do othe
