

Be due from the Ordinary Keepers, but also aff demand
 receive & take of all & every of the Attorneys now
 Practitioners in our Provincial Court (our Attorney
 Gen^t excepted) & which hereafter shall be admitted
 Attorneys in our said Court the summe of two hundred
 hundred pounds of tobacco yearly each person and
 upon default of paym^t of the several & respective
 quantitie^s of tobacco so to be paid by the said Ordinary
 Keepers as aforesaid, that it shal^t all & may be lawfull
 for our said Cousin to recall such Licence or Licences
 so by him granted or to be granted to such Ordinary
 Keeper or Ordinary keepers as above said And for default
 of payment of the several & respective quantitie^s of
 tobacco so to be paid by the said Attorney or practitioners
 in our said Provincial Court (except before excepted)
 as aforesaid That the said Attorney shall not be
 admitted to plead or prosecute any suit or action within
 our said Court and if hereafter it shall soon meet to
 us or our Lieut^t or Lieut^t & Council of our said
 Province to aduitt of any other or more Ordinary & to be
 kept at any other place or place within our said Province
 That then such Ordinary keeper or Ordinary keepers
 shall have such Licence or Licences from our said
 Cousin for the same, paying unto our said Cousin
 such summe of tobacco & money yearly as aforesaid
 vizt if in the City the summe of two thousand pds of tobacco
 & five & twenty shillings of annuite^t each person If in
 any other place the summe of two hundred pounds
 of tobacco & five & twenty shillings of annuite^t each
 person so to be licenced To have & to hold the abovesaid
 profits benifits & advantages (except above excepted)
 to him our said Cousin during our pleasure Given
 under our hand & letter seal the tenth day of June in
 the first yeare of our Dominion & Annoe d^r 1676.
