Esq<sup>r</sup> our Lieut: our own said Province of Maryland Given  
under our lesser Seal at Annapolis the fiftieth day of  
February in the third year of our dominion anno 1677

Whereas the severall Clerks of the respective Countyes  
within this Province have formerly bin very negligent  
in their severall Offices, by omitting (contrary to the  
Duty of their places & the Laws of this Province) to  
transfert into the Secretaries Office all such alienacion  
of lands as are entered upon Record on the severall County  
Court Books, not only to the great damage & prejudice of  
his Lord<sup>pp</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>rs</sup> of this Province in his rents  
since for alienacion, but also to the great confusion in  
the Rent Rolls of the respective Countyes, so that his Lord<sup>pp</sup>  
cannot many times come to the knowledge of the tenures  
by which meane in syne it may work a greater mischeif  
if previous remedy be not applied These are therefore  
(by & with the advice consent & approbation of his Lord<sup>pp</sup>  
Comittee) to will require & command the respective Justices  
of peace in each respective County immediately after the
