 his said Lord^{sh} to his Lieut^{nt} gen^l or to his Honorables
 gen^l for the tyme being a true & perfect extract of all
 such fines & Amerciam^{ts} as shall or may hereafter
 become due & payable to his said Lord^{sh} from the severall
 persons within their respective Countyes Every Clerk
 or Clerkes refusing or neglecting to transmitt such true
 Extract of the fines & Amerciam^{ts} within their
 respective Countyes as aforesaid by the tyme before
 limited, shall not only loose his or their place or place
 of Clerkshipp, but also be liable to such other fines &
 penalties as the Justices of the Provincia^l Court shall
 thinke fit to inflict upon them for their contempt And
 the Sheriffes of each respective County are hereby willed
 & required in due tyme to make Proclamacion hereof
 in the most publick & convenient places within their
 respective Countyes, to the end that all persons herein
 concerned may not plead ignorance for their neglect or
 contempt, if they shall not punctually observe and
 effectuallly performe what they are hereby required
