

Alward any of the aforesaid. Provisions with-  
out leave & licence first had & obtained as  
aforesaid And singularly the Offenders herein  
to be by the next Magistrate bound to their  
good behaviour giving good security for their  
appearance at the next Provincial Court  
to answer such their contempt And to this  
end that no person whatsoever herein  
mentioned may plead or pretend ignorance  
all Officers & others duly qualified to enter  
either Ships or other Vessels in this  
Province as well on behalfs of his Ma-  
jesty our Sovereign Lord the King of great  
Britain as on behalfs of his Lordship the  
Lord Proprietor of this Province are hereby  
willed & required to give notice hereof to  
all Merchants Or masters of Ships or other  
Vessels upon the entering of such their Ships  
or Vessels And whereas I am myself in-  
person absent indisposed & cannot be at  
St. Maryes to sign this Proclamation I do  
therefore by & with the advice & consent aforesaid  
herby authorize Ordaine & empower the  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> Philip Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Chamberlain of this  
Province to sign the same which is to be of as  
full force & validitie as if signed in my selfe.  
Given at the City of St. Maryes under the great  
Seale of this Province the fifth day of September  
in the third year of the Dominion of the right  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles our over this Province  
Dated 1678.
