 Inhabitants of our said Province of Maryland
 whom it may concerne are to take notice & to
 order their affaires accordingly And wee doe
 hereby order & command our respective Sheriffes
 of our severall Countyes that they upon sight of
 this our Proclamation immediately publish and
 proclaim the same, & give the respective
 Deputyes & Delegates of their severall Countyes
 particular notice of our will & pleasure herein
 Witness our selfe att our City of St. Maryes the
 seventeenth day of April in the second year of
 our Dominion of Charles the second 1678.

Charles the second all the Inhabitants of our Province of Marylands
 whereas wee did Surveys and Orders to hold a Generall Assembly
 of the Sheriffs and Delegates of our said Province of Maryland, at
 our City of St. Maryes the second Tuesday in May next Entering the
 date thereof which said day beinge now at hand for severall weighty
 and urgent occasions and affaires relating to us, wee have by the
 Advice and Consent of our Privy Councill of our said Province of
 Maryland thought fitt and doe hereby declare and publish, that
 the same Generall Assembly shall be and is hereby prorogued,
 the said second Tuesday in May next untill the sixth day of
 which shall be in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred
 seventy eight whereof as well our Members of our Upper
 house of Assembly, as also all the Deputyes and Delegates of our Lower
 house of Assembly, and all other the Inhabitants of our said
 Province of Maryland whom it may concerne are to take
 notice, and soe order their affaires accordingly and wee
