Heretofore for several weighty and urgent occasions affairs
 relating to our selfe and the state and welfare of this our
 Province Wood did hold a Generall Assembly at the City of St
 Marys the fifteenth day of May in the first year of our
 Dominion Anno Domini one thousand six hundred seventy
 six with four divers continuances hereunto moving. Wood
 did severally prorogued continued and prorogued the said until
 the tenth day of October then next following, w^{ch} said
 Assembly the thirteenth day of November then next following wood
 did prorogued until the second Tuesday in May then next
 following, w^{ch} upon the fourteenth day of March then next
 following wood did prorogued until the last Tuesday in September
 last past w^{ch} upon the thirteenth day of August last past
 wood did prorogued until the thirteenth day of April w^{ch}
 shall be in the year of our Lord god one thousand six hundred
 and eighty, w^{ch} said thirteenth day of April on w^{ch} the
