Assembly bee prorogued untill the seventh day of September
with shall bee in the year of Our Lord god One thousand six
hundred and eighty. And wee doe hereby will and require as
alsoe strictly charge and command, all and singular the Members
of this our Province, forthwith upon receipt hereof to make
proclamation hereof in the most convenient places within their
respective Counties, and to give notice to all and singular the
Delegates and Deputies by the freemen of their County
already elected, or for that purpose to bee elected, that all
excused sett a part they and every of the said Delegates and
personally appear at the said City of St Marys on the said
seventh day of September with shall bee in the year of our Lord
god one thousand six hundred and eighty, to doe and consent to
those things which then and there by the favor of god shall happon
to bee ordained by us by and with the advice and consent of our
grate Councell of this our Province touching the state and
welfare of this our Province, And alsoe to give notice to such
of our Councell as inhabit within their respective Counties
that all excused sett a part they alsoe bee and appear at the day
and place aforesaid to the end and purpose aforesaid. Given
at our City of St Marys under the grate seals of our said
Province of Maryland the thre and twentieth day of May
in the fifth year of our Dominion of Charles the second
One thousand six hundred seventy nine
