By the Lord Prop. A Proclamation

Whereas for severall weighty and Urgent occasions and  
 affairs relating to our self and the State and defence of  
 this our Province we did hold a Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly at the City  
 of St. Marys the fifteenth day of May in the first year  
 of our Dominion & Anno Domini 1676. w<sup>ch</sup> for divers  
 Considerations therein moving we did by Lawes  
 & Prorogations continue & prorogue the same until the 20<sup>th</sup>  
 day of October then next ensuing. w<sup>ch</sup> said Assembly  
 the fifteenth day of November then next following we did  
 prorogue until the second Tuesday in May then next  
 following, w<sup>ch</sup> upon the fourteenth day of March then  
 next ensuing we did prorogue until the last Tuesday in  
 September then next ensuing. w<sup>ch</sup> upon the sixteenth day
