 elected that all Excuses set apart they and every of  
 the said Deputies should personally appear at the said City  
 of St. Maries on the said fifth day of April last mentioned  
 to do and consent to those things which then and thence by  
 the favour of God shall happen to be ordained by us  
 by and with the advice & consent of our Great Council
