a Proclamation

WHEREAS for several weighty and urgent Occasions & Affairs
relating to Our Self and the State and Defence of this our Province
Wee did hold a generall Assembly at the City of St. Maries the fifth day
of May in the first year of our Dominion of Annoq^{uo} Domini One
thousand six hundred Seventy Six which for divers considerations the
thruunto moving we did by severall prorogations continue & prorogue
untille the twentieth Day of October then next ensuing, at the Assembly
the fifth day of November then next following we did prorogue
untille the second Tuesday in May then next following which upon the
fourteenth Day of March then next ensuing we did prorogue untille the
last Tuesday in September then next ensuing w^{ch} upon the sixteenth
day of August then next following we did prorogue untille the thirtieth
day of April last past w^{ch} said Assembly upon the three and twentieth
day of March last past we did prorogue untille the seventh day
of September last past, which upon the eighteenth Day of August
last
