 fifth Day of April now next ensuing, which said fifth Day of April
 on w^{ch} the said General Assembly should sit being now n^o: at hand, &
 no: urgent occasions or Affairs relating to the State or welfare of this our
 Province appearing for the convening and sitting of our said General
 Assembly on the said fifth Day of April, w^{ch} have Determined and
 ordered, And w^{ch} Do hereby fully & fully Determine and ordain that
 the said general Assembly be further prorogued until the Eleventh Day
 of October which shall be in the year of our Lord God One thousand
 Six hundred Eighty and One; And w^{ch} Do hereby will and require
 as also strictly charge and command all and singular the Sheriff of
 this our Province forthwith upon Receipt hereof to make Proclamation
 hereof in the most publick and convenient place within their respective
 Counties, and to give notice to all and singular the Delegates & Deputies
 by the Freeman of their County already elected or for that purpose
 to be elected that (all excepted sett apart) they and every of the said
 Delegates come and personally appear at the City of St. Marys
 on the said Eleventh Day of October last mentioned to do and
 confer to those things which then and there by the favor of God
 shall happen to be ordained by Us by and with the Advice & consent
 of our great Council of this our Province concerning the State
 and welfare of this our Province; And also to give notice to such
 of our Council as inhabit in their respective Counties that (all
 excepted sett apart) they also be and appear at the Day & place
 aforesaid in the Upper House of our said General Assembly to the Ends &
 purposes aforesaid. Given at our City of St. Marys under the great
 Seal of our said Province of Maryland the Eight and twentieth Day
 of February in the sixth year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini
 One thousand Six hundred and Eighty.
