 and Custome of this Province, And we do also hereby  
 grant unto you all other powers and privileges rights and  
 jurisdiction lawfully belonging to a Court for making probate  
 of Wills or Granting Letters of Administration as aforesaid  
 and all due and just fees profits and Emoluments belonging to  
 a Judge or Judges of such a Court as shall be agreed and  
 settled by us or our Lieutenants and Council in our Province  
 saving to all and every person and persons that shall come  
 hereunto aggrieved their Lawfull appeals to us or in our  
 absence to our Lieutenants of this Province for by them being  
 or such other person or persons as we or our Lieutenants  
 shall appoint to hear and determine the same. To have full  
 power and enjoy the Office of Judge and Commissary full  
 aforesaid in our Province unto you our Lieutenants, and so  
 to remaine and continue do and enjoye all and singularly  
 promised till we shall signify our will and pleasure to  
 the contrary. Given at our City of St. Maries under our  
 hand and great Seal of our Province the six and twenty  
 day of January in the eighth year of our Dominion over  
 this our Province Annoq. Domini 1682.

on the back of w<sup>ch</sup> foregoing Commission was written the following Endorsement viz<sup>t</sup>

We do by this our Endorsement under our hand give and grant  
 unto the within named Henry Darnall and William Digger  
 power and Authority to depose such person in their absence  
 from the Office as they shall think fitt to be sworn signing  
 and sealing of all Commissions for probate of wills and  
 granting of Administrations of what Nature or Quality soever  
 and for the Administring Oaths relating to the Office aforesaid.

Do hereby empower you John Darnall to Administer the Oath  
 of this Judge for probate of wills and granting Letters of  
 Administration as also the oath of the great Seal
