for the time being shall at any time think fitt to have  
executed in relation to the office hereby given you the  
said George Calbot hereby revoking a Commission formerly  
granted to Vincent Lewis Esq. for the same place of  
Generall Juror given under our hand & great  
seale of our said province this eighth day of November  
in the eighth year of our Dominion over our said  
province of Maryland Annoq. Dni 1683.

If George Calbot doe regard that I will kindly  
and faithfully serve the said his Lord's property  
in the office & place of his Deputy Generall Juror  
and in all things relating to that office I will doe  
his best for all the good people of his province
