Then appeared William Sharp & Robert Webb &
according to their Recognizances exhibited into at
Talbot County Court did it wad alledged against
them that the said Robert Webb shoud report at
the house of Regard Ryston that william sharp
told him that he & said sharp had an order
from his Lord^s prop^r for the raising
and fortning of a place oldonake a sould to serve
him the said William Sharp & the said Robert
Webb made o^r before this Boarde that he
wad told by sharp that he had any such order
did that he did not report so at Ryston cause
but that the matter was as followeth
that sharp w^t a Lrd to him requesting him if
conuenient permitted to talk at Regard Ryston
house & enquired for a young man that came into
his Country in swillbace shipp a sould by trade
had bin lately in suche for his freedom and informed
him from him he said sharp that sharp had an
esquire of him for the custome of the Country
that sharp desired him to w^t by faire meane
he would be tuck to him & advised that sharp
would haue a poore from none of the smaller
Country and shud an hundryd after him of
him by force & did assur^r him that if he ge^r
Ryston Ryston w^t ruin him all whiche he
webb wad then to Ryston & did brought him
one card to the said sharp house —

In Regard nothing appeared before this Boarde
a paper wherein four persons oaths hould
in due officidit, and noe body appearing against them
