Proclam: to prorog:
1683.

Whereas for several weighty and urgent occasions & affairs relating
to the State and the State and D. of this our Province, We did by
Proclamation bearing date the 20th day of July last past declare
the calling of a new Assembly to begin and be holden at the City of
St. Marks the 12th Day of October then next following, which said
Assembly We did by Proclam: bearing date the 10th day of Sep:
1683. last past prorogue until the 24th Day of October then next
following And from thence by Proclam: bearing date the 5th
Day of October We did also further prorogue the same until the
10th and 11th Day of the same October, which accordingly then
next and last at our S. City of St. Marks, and there continued until
the 15th day of November last past, and was from thence further
prorogued until the first Tuesday in March next ensuing, which
said Assembly We did by Proclamation bearing date the 10th and
11th day of January then next following further prorogue
until the eighth day of May then next ensuing, which said
eighth day of May on which our S. Assembly should sit being
now next at hand, and no urgent occasions or affairs relating
to the State or welfare of this our Province appearing for
the calling and sitting of our said Assembly on the said eighth day of May
We have by and with the advice and consent of our Council determined
and ordained, And we do hereby fully resolve, determine and ordain
that the same Assembly be prorogued until the fourth day of September
now next ensuing, And we do hereby will and require as also
strictly charge and command all and singular the Sheriffs of this
our Province forthwith upon Receipt hereof to make proclamation
hereof in the most convenient place within their respective
Counties, and to give notice to all and singular the Deputies & Deputies
by the Freeman of their Counties already elected, or for that purpose to be
elected that all persons free apart they and every of the said Deputies
and Deputies come and personally appear at the S. City of St. Marks
on the 4th day of September now next ensuing to do and
consent to those things which then and there by the favour of God
shall happen to be ordained by us by and with the advice and consent
of our great Council of this our Province concerning the State and
welfare of this our Province; And also to give notice to such of our
