

In the Sheriff, And the said Wicks said that he would have his order observed or else he would be no body.

Thirdly

That on the 25th January by the order of the S. Mill and Evert Court George Green Esq. of the Court made Proclamation for Capt. William Lawrence Esq. of your High Justice by the title of a Mann Child - about 52 years of age, and if any person or persons would carry him before the S. Mill and Evert, should be well paid for their pains, there by -

Fourthly

And regarding and dividing your High Justice. - That the 14th of the said Attachment was granted the S. Mill against the Estate of one William Batman, by virtue whereof the S. Mill and Evert the said Estate, and made sale thereof without any condemnation, and also seized all the papers, amongst which was said to be a discharge from the S. Mill to J. Batman of all debts due and demands, Mr. Hojier did own that Batman had such a receipt in open Court from the S. Mill but would not produce it; also Mr. Hojier did attach 1700: tob. in the hands of Mr. Hamblen and 1000: tob. of the S. Ringold in the hands of John Hussey, by the title of Batmans Estate, but gave no return therefor nor making any return of the Attachment as touching the S. Cobacco, but so much as came to be called Batmans Estate properly belongs to the Orphan of William Stanley Esq. died.

Fifthly

July 25th 1682: being presented before at the house of the S. Mill - All Orphan Estates real and personal were appraised by Jury - Stanley Orphan excepted and the charge arising there of was said to be 10 or 12000 tob. but no law produced for that unnecessary charge.

Sixthly

August 28th 1683: All actions depending in the Court were left fall by order of the S. Wicks Hojier and Miller. September 25th 1683: No: full Court, therefore adjourned by the said Justice Wicks Hojier and Miller.

These reasons though the S. Ringold could show much more the Hojiers are sufficient for not joining with the S. Commission in their unjust illegal way of proceedings suffered and done, besides several absurdities and abuses offered him in relation to his Office all which he leaves to his High Consideration, and prays his High writ of Habeas in that affair.
