


that my Lord did nothing in it, Carvill replied that the said

 where the said Ladyship and the said Carvill wife was, the said Mr.  
 Doyn the said Carvill wife had complained of Justice done her  
 husband at the Provinciale Court, And this said the said Carvill wife  
 was all the redress the old spirit full word (the said Ladyship meaning)  
 gave her, and further the said Doyn say no

Command was then given to the Sheriff of St. Marys County to  
 take good and sufficient Security of Thomas Carvill here in his  
 custody for his good abstinence and appearance at the next Provinciale  
 Court before his Justice there to answer unto such things as  
 should then and there be objected against him in behalf of his  
 the Lord Prop: of this Province.



At a Council held at the ~~Provinciale~~ Battle Town:  
 the 13<sup>th</sup> Day of February Anno Domini 1683:

Read off of this Board the severall Dispositions against Robert  
 Carvill as also the Disposition of William Simpson and Mary the  
 wife against Thomas Carvill, ordered that they be all delivered to  
 the said Attorney Generall to prosecute, and that Thomas Carvill  
 be first brought to his tryall.
