At hearing wherof they seemed to startle; the Gov:mo: & Councell  
therupon resolved to quitt y Roome to them and allow them some  
time to consider and return their Answer

After som. paus having consulted awhile Chotike is ordred  
to answer for them in manner folo: as it

That they are very sad and troubled at y accident, the  
English and they having always bin in: (as they say)  
that they were sensible and did then acknowledge th: ~  
English had bin their greater friend, by whose aid and  
assistance and under whose protection they had sustaine-  
d without, that they very well knew they had many enemies, and  
the English only their friends whome they could depend on, and  
if once they should break with them, they must certainly  
be most miserable, expecting nothing but Death that as  
touching th: mord. & y d. mord. of the English therupon  
they could al psonl giv<sup>e</sup> no psonl positive answer as nor  
being yet sensible who were the murderers, that they will make  
it their Busyness to find out y truth and make strict in-  
quisition amongst all their young men, and rewarding what  
in them li: to find out y murderers, that on Tuesday th: 27<sup>th</sup>  
instant they will rend an Acco: of their proceedings & giv<sup>e</sup>

their further answer to what has been offred to them this day.

W<sup>t</sup> Mr: Board being concluded on, Councell are ordred to meet again  
at same place Tuesday 27 January 1638.
