

That they do not presume to Demand a fee or receive any other or
 greater fee for a writt of cap. ad satis fac. more then the just and
 Legall fee for serving y^e same and for r. cas. together with 20. tob. off
 Dim imprisonment. so long as the ffly shall actually remaine in Custody
 and no more as they will answer the contrary at their utmost perill
 And further where as severall Sherriffes have exacted and extorted from
 severall Inhabitants of this Province an Exorbitant fee of One hundred
 and Ten pounds of tob. for serving a Citation from y^e Chancery
 that y^e same not belonging to y^e Sherriffes Office, the Sherriff serving y^e same
 ought to have an extraordinary fee w^{ch} is altogether unreasonable & highly
 burthenfome to y^e Inhabitants Now to prevent the like for y^e future y^e Do:
 hereby by & with y^e advice and consent aforesaid publish & make known
 that no more then twenty pounds of tobacco shall be hereafter allowed for
 serving any citation from the Chancery any Rule or ord. of Court to
 y^e contrary notwithstanding, and y^e Do: hereby strictly charge & command
 all and singular the Sherriffes of this Province to serve all such Citations
 as they shall from time to time receive from y^e Chancery Office, exacting
 or Demanding no greater fee or gratuity for y^e same then y^e summe of twenty
 lbs of tob. as aforesaid as they will answer y^e contrary at their perill And
 y^e Do: hereby will and require all and singular his Loppes Justices of y^e Peace
 within this Province that they take care & cause the premises to be made
 known and proclaimed by the Sherriff of their County or his Deputy in the
 most publick place of their County, causing a Coppy hereof fairly to be
 transcribed and affixed to y^e Door of the County Court House where they serve
