Upon hearing and Examination of the whole matter the Substan-
 ce gathered from thence was that the Peticon & his wife having had
 several Differences between them wh. could not be composed did
 severall declare that they were fully resolved never any more to
 live together. She desiring an allowance proportionable to what
 she had at her Intermarriage with him. He declared himself willing to
 allow her such a reasonable maintenance as the Governo. and Council should
 think fit to award her with due consideration had to her Capacity
 & wch. at last they both referred to the Discretion of the Governo. and
 Council to ord. wherein what to them should seeme wch. they would
 submitt to.

The Governo. and Council having Duly and maturely considered the
 premises Did ord. as follows

Octob. 24th 1678: By the Governo. and Council.

Whereas appaird b. for ye Governo. and Council this Day Robert
 Liffey of Calvert County & Elizabeth his wife did jointly and
 severally openly declare that for severall differences both publick and
 private they were fully resolved never to cohabit together againe and
 forasmuch as the said Elizabeth did demand a reasonable maintenance
 to be allowed her by her husband wch. he readily consented to they both
 submitting themselves to the Discretion of the Governo. and Council to
 apportion same as to them should seeme meet. It is Ordained.

That the said Robert Liffey pay or cause to be paid yearly and
 every year unto the said Elizabeth his wife for and During her
 naturall life the summe of two thousand poundes of tobacco
 for a maintenance and no more.

At a Council held at John Baker house at the City of St. Marie the
 26th Day of October in the third year of the Dominion of the R. Hon. Charles
 Gascoigne over this Province Amoqz Comini 1678.
