

to give notice to y^e English of his near approach, and if any English man shall kill any Indian that shall come unpainted & give such notice & deliver up his Arms as a Forger shall die for it, as well as an Indian that kills an English man, and in case the Indians and English meet in the woods accidentally, Every Indian shall be bound immediately to throw down his Arms upon call and in case any Indian for meeting any English man shall refuse to throw down his Arms upon call he shall be deemed as an Enemy.

4^{thly} The Priviledge of hunting, Crabbing, Fowling, and fishing shall be preserved to y^e Indians Inviolable.

5^{thly} If any Indian Steal an Hogg or Calf, or other Beast, or any other goods He shall undergo y^e same punishment that an English man doth for y^e same Offence.

6^{thly} In case any servants or Slaves run away from their Masters or Children from their Parents, and come to any of the Indian Towns within the Territories of the Empero^r of Spattaga or the Kings before mentioned, they shall be bound to apprehend y^e fugitives, and bring them to the next English Plantation, to be conveyed to their Masters, and in case any Indian aforesaid shall convey or assist any such fugitives in their flight out of this Province he shall make y^e respective Ma^r or Ma^rs of such Slave or Slaves such Satisfaction as any English man ought to do in like case.

7^{thly} The Empero^r & Kings aforesaid shall not make any new peace nor shall not make any War without y^e consent of y^e Hon^{ble} Lord Prop^r for y^e time being.

8^{thly} In case y^e Empero^r or Kings aforesaid or any Indian subject to them belonging shall kill a Native or any of the Indians, or any other in peace & Amity wth y^e Lord Prop^r shall be esteemed as great an Offence as killing an English man.

9^{thly} That in case any Indian or Indians of any other Nation or Nations shall come within their Dominions or Territories and shall by them or any other Indians und^{er} them be entertained by any of y^e Indians shall kill any English, or kill or destroy any Hogs, cattle or Horses, or shall break up any English mans house, or shall take his or their goods, y^e Hon^{ble} Empero^r & Kings aforesaid shall be responsible for y^e same, and in case he or she shall have knowledge of any other murder or killed David Williams & his Family, y^e they shall be hereby engaged to deliver them up to y^e next Magistrate to be him conveyed to y^e Hon^{ble} as soon as found.

10^{thly} That y^e Empero^r of Spattaga & Kings of Tokomohi, Ingokag, Nuswattap, Amam, Nequeantia & Morumco shall well pay to y^e Hon^{ble} Lord Prop^r upon y^e 1st of Nov^r in y^e Tokomohi now called Kihoboth, to such person as shall be appointed thereto to receive y^e same by y^e Hon^{ble} Lord Prop^r his Heirs & Successors or L^{ieut} Gen^l for y^e time being y^e Indian Arrows yearly upon the 5th Day of October as an Acknowledgment of his Right Dominion over them and also as a pt^l of y^e peace.
