 to signify to the Choctico Indian the **Sup: Will and pleasure**, and  
 that **Jam: Smallwood** Do: the said Mattawoman and Nainmy  
 Indian, who is also acquainted with the **Sasattoway** Indian with this respect  
 of the **Sup: and his Council** to their request.

**Maris County** forthwith upon receipt hereof give notice to the King  
 and great men of Choctico that this is his **Sup: will and pleasure**  
 directing them to comply therewith upon Demand thereof made  
 by the said **Sasattoway** Indians Dated the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of June  
 in the fourth year of the Dominion of the **Rt Hon: Charles**

 Indian und: the Governm:) And that **Jam: Smallwood** of  
**Charls County** upon receipt hereof forthwith make the King & great  
 men of **Mattawoman** and **Nainmy** acquainted with the **Sup:**  
**Will and pleasure**, and also to advise the **Sasattoway** Indians  
 thereof and that the **Sup: and Council** have given the ord:  
 to the Choctico Indian for a further supply of twenty men -  
 according to their request, Dated the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of June in the  
 fourth year of the Dominion of the **Rt Hon: Charles the Amaz:**
