 execution of this your precept you are to address your self in
 your way thither to Mr. John Stone of your County who is
 hereby writt and required to accompany you to the Said Casattoway
 fort, and to afford you his advice and assistance as Intrep.
 follow: as you and your Indians in such matters and things as you
 shall think fit to propose to them, and they shall again offer
 to you in order to your better Information concerning the same. As
 also whereof as will you the Said Capt. Randolph Braud as
 also the Said John Stone and your hands you are to send. Unto Us
 by Monday next the 12. day of May instant without fail. In order
 whereunto you are hereby Authoriz'd and empowered to press men
 whosoever in any part of your County as well for conveyance of the Said
 unto Us the Said 12. day of May instant as also from time to time
 and at all times hereafter when and as often as occasion shall
 require or you shall find convenient for any further discovery
 or Intelligence which may be happen to be made to you any way concern-
 ing the same. Whereof fail not and for so doing this shall
 be your warrant. Given under our hand and Seal at Arm. d. the
 12. day of May in the fifth year of our Dominion &c.

Yours of y^e 17. days last this morning I recd. concerning the
 Intelligence you recd. from a Casattoway Indian concerning the
 Sinniquo and Susquehannoh Indians being come downe about 300 of
 them and Intrep. neere the Casattoway fort. I thank you for your
 care in advising it, and have given order to Capt. Braud
 what I thought necessary to be done therein at present, and shall take
 what further care therein may be necessary. I am
