Whereas Divers ~~Foreign~~ Indians have lately made some Incursions into
Baltimore County, and have assaulted several the Inhabitants thereto
the great terror and amazement of all the said Inhabitants, who are but
a small number and unable to defend themselves if any greater attempt
should be made upon them; It is therefore ordered that at what time
soever *Col George Wiers* Command^r in Chief of all his ~~High~~ Majesty's
Foot-Militia in *P. County* shall have occasion to apply himself to
you *Col William Burgis* for Assistance you forthwith supply him
with such a number of able men out of your County and Regiment as
he shall desire, and the occasion may require. Whereof you are not
to fail.

Yours of the 20th instant with other Papers Inclosed from
Capt Waterson and *Thomas Richardson* freed relating all to the late
unwelcome Encounter with the Indians, for your care in advising
I give you thanks, but cannot make Nothing of the others from *Waterson*
and *Richardson*, the former of whom hath so rashly and unadvisedly
ordered that I cannot but highly reprove, and therefore desire y^e to
Demand of him an Account by what Power he hath so done
accordingly as you are directed by the Inclosed ord^r of Council w^{ch} will
be y^e further guide in the managment of affaires at present as they now
stand, w^{ch} may follow and observe, I have likewise sent you power
to press *Boats* and *Hand* to come down to *Mattaponi* and to convey
to you some supply of *Arms* and *Ammunition* for Defense of
your County, the same you are to Distribute among the Inhabitants & take
a particular Acc^t thereof and to whom disposed that they may reimburse

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
